Talk to your child about service. Emphasize the fact that God is happy when we help others.



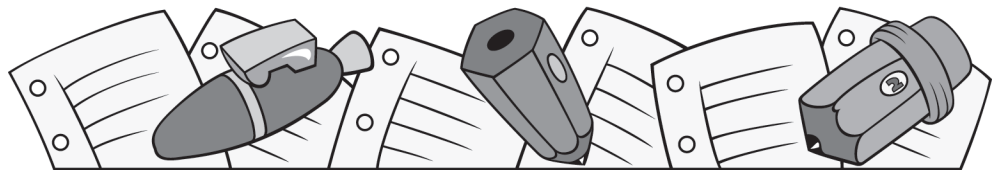
**TODAY IN JUNIOR SOLDIERS** the children learned how The Salvation Army helps people who are facing times of difficulty. They learned about what The Salvation Army is doing around the world to help people who've been affected by war, natural disasters, and personal struggles.

Today, The Salvation Army works in 126 countries. Each corps faces unique challenges while serving its community in Jesus' name. Whether serving Thanksgiving dinner to the homeless, or providing cleaning supplies to victims of weather-related disasters, The Salvation Army consistently helps people who are in need physically, financially, emotionally, and spiritually.

Through the years, The Salvation Army has provided emergency relief for individuals and entire communities during times of disaster. Each year Salvationists are "mobilized" to different parts of the world to assist in The Salvation Army's relief efforts.

All Salvationists (young and old) can take part in The Salvation Army's service. You don't have to go overseas, or serve on a canteen during a disaster to take part. Some Salvationists participate by donating food, needed supplies, or money. Others participate through prayer.

Even the smallest child can make a big impact on The Salvation Army's service by praying for The Salvation Army, its workers, and the recipients of service.
