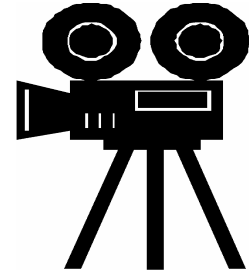
REQUIREMENT #2 - Basic Drama Terms
